### **Application for Training**

Potential trainees should register with the Training Subcommittee of the BFS when they decide to start the training. Application forms are available at: <http://www.fertility.org.uk/education/index.html>

Candidates seeking to register for Certification in Pelvic Ultrasound should:

1. Be a member of the BFS
2. Undertake training over an agreed period of time (normally a minimum of 6 months, and a maximum of 12 months) in a Centre recognised as a "Training Centre" by the BFS, under the guidance of designated trainer(s).
3. Have a basic medical qualification e.g. MB ChB or be a fertility nurse and must be a member of the BFS.
4. Provide payment of £120 payable to the British Fertility Society
5. Attend the Pelvic Ultrasound Study Day approved by the BFS.
6. Keep a logbook detailing experience in pelvic ultrasound examinations.
7. Keep a record of monthly appraisals with their trainer.
8. At the end of training apply for accreditation by:
  - i. Submission of a Certificate of attendance at the Study Day
  - ii. Submission of the Logbook and Appraisal Record.
  - iii. Submission of letter of support from their trainer.
